Introduction and Vote Weekend for Associate Pastor/Young Adults Candidate

We are pleased to announce that the Associate Pastor of Young Adults Search Team, the Personnel Committee, and the Ministerial Staff have unanimously agreed to recommend a candidate to serve as our Associate Pastor of Young Adults. This recommendation comes after the church in conference (February 10, 2019) unanimously approved the job description for this position and authorized the Personnel Committee to begin a search for an Associate Pastor of Young Adults. There were nearly 40 resumes received for this 25-28 hour week position.

The candidate will be present with us on the weekend on **June 1-2**. We will adhere to the following schedule:
