

Back to School 2020: A Year Unlike Any Other!

Most public school students in Hampton Roads including all the Peninsula return to school on Tuesday, September 8. Due to COVID 19, however, this school year will be markedly different. Nearly all the school systems in our area are starting out with virtual learning for the next 9 weeks (Poquoson will have some in-person learning). Teachers are trying to learn a new digital platform (Canvas) at lightening speed, parents are trying to figure out how to support their children and work, single parents are working on solutions for supervising and caring for their children while they work, and many families across the Peninsula with limited internet service and technology are wondering if they will simply fall further behind. We have not even mentioned the struggles principals, administrators and school staff members are facing.

Finally, students across our region and nation are having to learn to do school connected to technology and disconnected from their personal time with their friends. Many have lost the opportunity to play Fall sports, participate in marching band and enjoy other extra-curricular opportunities.

I am reminding you of these realities for one reason. I want you to PRAY. Pray daily for our teachers in public and private schools who are learning to teach in new ways. This is a huge challenge for all of them. An updated list of our church members and attendees who teach is included below. Please pray for them by name and for the administrators and staffers who lead and support them (call the church office if you know someone we need to add to the list). If you have extra time to pray open the school website of school closest to you and pray for each person by name on the faculty list. Just PRAY....

PRAY for parents. Pray for them as they support their children learning virtually. Pray for those who have chosen to homeschool their children, especially new homeschooling parents. Pray for the anxiety parents face as they love and encourage their children during these new school days. Pray for their patience, encouragement, and relief from anxiety. Just PRAY....

PRAY for students. Pray for them when the technology fails. Pray for them when they do not understand assignments. Pray for them when they miss their friends. Pray for them when they struggle to learn through a connection to a computer screen. Pray for them when they feel lonely, anxious, and scared. Just PRAY....

Friends, I know we will get through this. Our teachers will adapt, learn, and find ways to inspire the next generation even in these nine weeks. Parents will love their children and find strength in God's grace. Students will persevere, and grow through adversity. It will, however, be a tremendous challenge. As a church family, let's commit to PRAY them through these days.
