

Sanctuary Air Conditioner Replacement Project Underway

Beginning Monday, October 5, a contractor began replacing our 70-ton (that's big!) air conditioner that serves the sanctuary. It will take two weeks to complete this complicated project and the sanctuary will be substantially without air conditioning during that time. We do have another unit that serves the balcony area that was replaced this summer. If you happen by the church over the next two weeks you may see several contractor vehicles and perhaps a crane or other equipment needed to make this project happen. We timed this project so that it would happen during cooler or more temperate climate conditions. The new replacement unit should last us another 20-25 years once completed.
