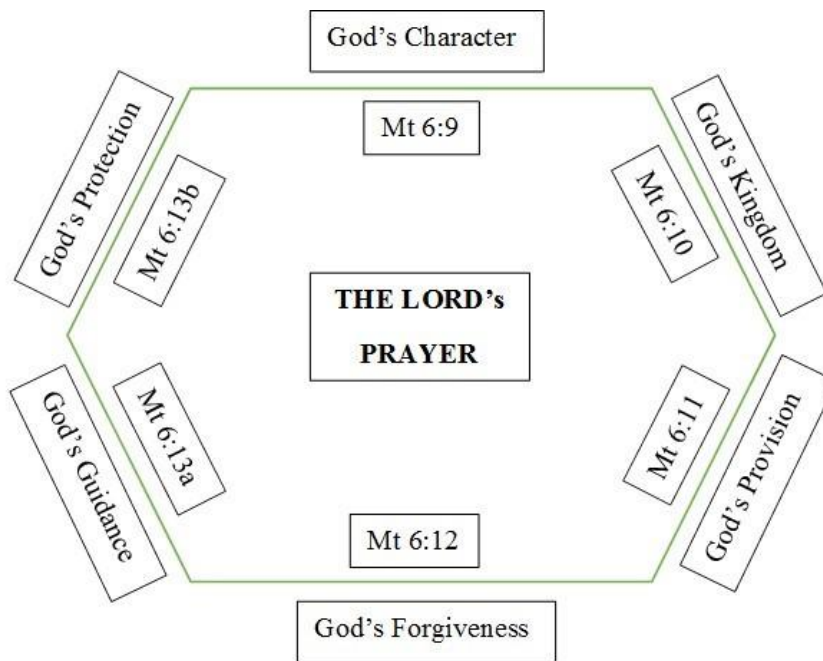
Change in Worship Services!

The Hexagon of the Lord's Prayer

For those of you with us for online worship on Sunday, you will remember that our sermon was rooted in the Lukan version of the Lord's prayer (Luke 11:1-4). We talked about how Luke's context for the Lord's prayer was so important. It reminds us that we have to learn to pray. We are always beginning when it comes to prayer, even if we have prayed all of our lives. I encourage you to watch the sermon if you missed it, watch it again, and share it with your friends.

One of the illustrations I used during the sermon was the Hexagon of the Lord's Prayer. I read about this in Mike Breen's book *Building a Discipling Culture*. In fact, Breen has built a whole model of discipleship that uses shapes as mnemonic devices for discipleship learning and practice. It is a creative and inventive approach. Thinking about the hexagon helps me organize my thoughts and flow of prayer according to the pattern of the Lord's prayer. I am hopeful the hexagon will be another helpful pattern in your tool kit of prayer. The following depiction of the hexagon comes from Brentwood Baptist Church in Nashville, TN and uses Matthew's version of the Lord's prayer. On Sunday, we focused on the first two sides: God's Character and God's Kingdom. Join us for online worship this Sunday as we study the final four sides of the Lord's Prayer hexagon and learn how to pray them as well.
