# Commissioning for Pastor Juan's Sabbatical Takes Place This Sunday

This Sunday, May 15, we will have one combined worship service for our English and Hispanic congregations. We will worship together at 11:00 in our sanctuary. While we will enjoy praising God and worshipping in English and in Spanish as we do at all of our quarterly combined services, we will also commission Pastor Juan Garcia as he leaves for his sabbatical. Juan will begin his sabbatical leave on Monday, May 16 and return on September 5. If you would like a refresher on Juan's sabbatical plan and experience, please read the article in our April 20 issue of First News here.

I would like to invite all of you to join me in praying for Pastor Juan, Monica, Natalia, Daniel, our Hispanic congregation, and our church as a whole during Juan's sabbatical season. Here is a pattern for prayer that you can use during this sabbatical season:

<u>Sunday</u>: Pray for our Hispanic congregation as they live out their calling while Juan is gone. Pray for those who preach and lead in worship. Pray for their spiritual renewal even while their Pastor is renewed on sabbatical. Pray for our church as a whole as we treasure and support our Hispanic congregation.

Monday: Pray for deep rest for Juan and safety as he and his family travel

Tuesday: Pray for a renewed sense of call and direction in Juan

**Wednesday**: Pray for Juan to experience recreation, fun, and the joy of the Lord

<u>Thursday</u>: Pray for Monica, Natalia, and Daniel as they spend time away from Juan during portions of his sabbatical

**<u>Friday</u>**: Pray for marriage and family renewal for the Garcia family

**Saturday**: Pray for God to refresh and renew Juan's soul

As part of finding rest and replenishment, Juan will completely disconnect from his responsibilities in order to focus on reconnection with God. Therefore, he will not be available by phone, email, text, social media, or appointment for the duration of his sabbatical. If you have a question for Juan during this sabbatical season, you can reach out to Pastor Randy or another member of the ministerial staff.

In addition, Pastor Juan will spend a good portion of his sabbatical leave away from Newport News, but he will be in town for some weeks as well. It is possible you will see him out with his family or even handling errands that are necessary while he is in town. If you see him, please bear in mind that he is living in a sabbatical rhythm that has him unplugged from church for replenishment. So, greet him, assure him of your prayers, and refrain from an

extended conversation, especially if it is about church! Help him maintain his sabbatical rhythms of rest.

I hope to see all of you here on Sunday at 11:00, in person or online, for our combined worship service, and our time of commissioning for Pastor Juan's sabbatical day. It will be a significant day in the life of our church.

### **Donation Opportunity for Those with IRA Required Minimum Distributions (RMD)**

Congress has approved a permanent charitable giving tax break, known as the "IRA charitable rollover". The rollover is available for those who are 70 1/2, though if your 70th birthday is July 1, 2019 or later, you do not have to take withdrawals until you reach age 72. You can make a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA of up to \$100,000 to a charity, such as First Baptist Church. The donation will count toward your IRA required minimum distribution.

The distribution is not recognized as income on your tax return. As such, you do not take a donation deduction either. With the change in the recent Tax Legislation, the Standard Deduction has doubled thus itemized charitable deductions will no longer be needed to be kept track of. By donating all or part of your IRA RMD to the church, you receive the benefit of a reduced Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) in that the RMD to charity is not taxed, which helps the opportunity of obtaining lower cost for your Medicare Part B and Prescription Drug premiums.

The distribution must come directly from the IRA account to the church not through the owner of the account. Let our Financial Services Coordinator, Monica Garcia, know how you want the contribution designated, such as the General Fund.
