Joining us for worship this Sunday is Michael Pumphrey. Michael is a church planter, strategist, coach, and cultural


architect who works with existing churches and church planters, helping them reimagine what the church can look like in our day.

Half of this money is going to Camp Harghita in Romania and the other half to Project Ruth. Both of these organizations have been taking in refugees and providing assistance to those affected by the war.

Please continue to remember Gennady and Mina Podgaisky in your prayers. They served in Kyiv, Ukraine beginning in December 2002 and helped establish the Village of Hope which was destroyed earlier this year. The Podgaisky's will be coming here one Sunday in August as guest preachers.
