Preoccupied With Christ



Greetings to all of you! I am honored to have the opportunity to serve as the Pastoral Intern at First Baptist Church of Newport News for the next 10 weeks. As part of my experience I have been given the opportunity to have a space within *First News*, as well as on the FBCNN Facebook and Instagram pages, to write and reflect on the relationship between what has been known throughout Christian history as the "Spirit-filled Life", and the practice of "Mindfulness." Mainly, what does it mean to have the triune God dwell within the believer through the person of the Holy Spirit and what does it look like for a believer to cultivate and live out their faith in light of this reality?

In my seminary training I had ample time and space to read, study, reflect, pray, and have conversations around the table regarding this topic. Once I graduated and began to have the opportunity to do the work of the ministry, I quickly realized that all of that "head knowledge" was meaningless if it stayed there as only facts. There needed to be a transfer of those facts to a living and active life of faith through the power of the Holy Spirit. This sent me on a search for what the Apostle Paul refers to as the "Glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27).

In order to lay a foundation for the weeks to come, I encourage you to take time to ponder what Paul means by the statement, "Christ *in* you", with an emphasis on "*in*." As he states, this is a beautiful mystery which provides the believer with hope that is unlike anything this world has ever, and will ever, know. I believe this is a vital truth that has been overlooked and/or under-emphasized in our modern Christian circles but is the essence of the power of God living within us and is the source of Paul's benediction to the Thessalonians: "May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."








First Baptist Preschool Registering!
