Who is this Spirit?

Greetings to all of you in Jesus Christ!

I feel that in order to progress in the knowledge of what it looks like for the believer to work out of the power of the Holy Spirit, it is imperative that we understand who the Spirit is and what His purpose is for believers in Christ. Only then can we fully understand the power that God has so graciously sent to live inside of us.

The Holy Spirit is one of the three persons of the triune God, alongside the Father and the Son. He is distinct in his personhood, yet without division in nature, essence, or being from the Father or the Son (BF&M, 1963). We do not have the space here to flesh out all of who the Holy Spirit is, but scripture speaks of him as our advocate and teacher (John 14:26), intercessor (Romans 8:27), and sanctifier (Romans 15:16). When I sit down and consider who the Holy Spirit is for me, I have reassurance and hope that he is the literal Spirit of God; the same Spirit that was with God as they created the cosmos together (Genesis 1:2) is the same Spirit that came upon King David in his youth (1 Samuel 16:13), is the same Spirit that conceived the Messiah in the virgin Mary's womb (Matthew 1:18-20), is the same Spirit that empowered and guided Jesus Christ as he walked with us in this world (John 3:34), which is the same Spirit that Jesus sent to us after his glorious ascension back to the Father (Acts 1:8) and is the very Spirit that empowers the believer to understand the things of God (1 Corinthians 2:10-16).

I know that when I came to a fuller understanding of the Spirit of God that is alive and active within my heart, it developed a deep passion in my soul to cultivate the depth of my faith. My prayer is that you will take time this week to meditate on who the Holy Spirit is and, in doing so, that He will continue to develop within you a deep desire that is receptive to Him in your daily living. May He cultivate a yearning in your heart to "keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God." (Colossians 3:1).

Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing.


