



The Holy Spirit: From the Head to the Heart

Grace & Peace to you in the name of Jesus Christ!

We know that the Holy Spirit lives in us, and we took a survey of who He is; now what do we do with that information? There must be a transfer of the knowledge of who the Spirit is from the head to the heart.

In Ezekiel 36, God promises purification to Israel. He declares, "A new heart I will give you, and a new spirit I will put within you, and I will remove from your body the heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. I will put my spirit within you and make you follow my statutes and be careful to observe my ordinances." (vs. 26-27, NRSV). Jesus echoes this same truth in John 3:5 by stating, "Very truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit" (NRSV). Thanks be to Jesus Christ that through his life, death, resurrection, and ascension, He made the way for purification through the Holy Spirit for all who believe by faith!

A Christian is a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17). The first step in that process is a spiritual heart transplant. God replaces the "heart of stone" with a "heart of flesh." The essence of the believer as a human being is forever changed! They can now live "in step with the Spirit" (Gal. 5:25, ESV). Does this mean that after this spiritual operation one will always live in that state? As the Apostle Paul exclaims, "By no means!" Paul talks openly about his battle between the desires of the flesh and the desires of the Spirit (Rom. 7-8). As God's people, living in a fallen world and awaiting our King's arrival, there is a tension in our lives between God and Satan, a spiritual battle. Paul describes the way Christians can overcome their worldly desires as they continue in their sanctification: "Walk by the Spirit and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh" (Gal. 5:16, ESV). This is an invitation: we can choose to walk in the power of the Holy Spirit who dwells within us, or we can choose to live out of our fleshly, human nature. Next week we will begin our exploration of how to cultivate our Spirit-filled life in order to progress in our sanctification!

Sanctuary Choir

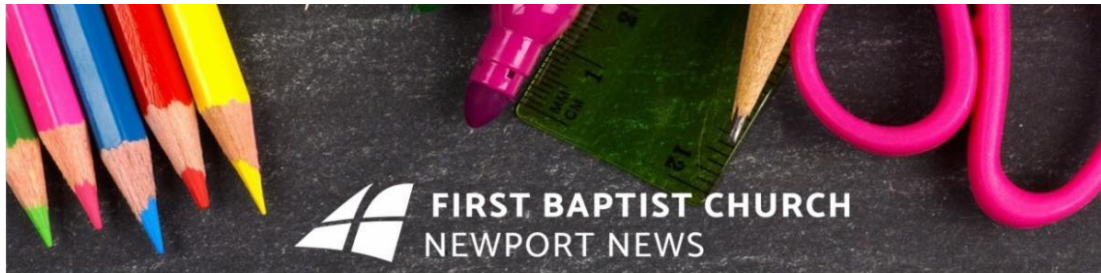


