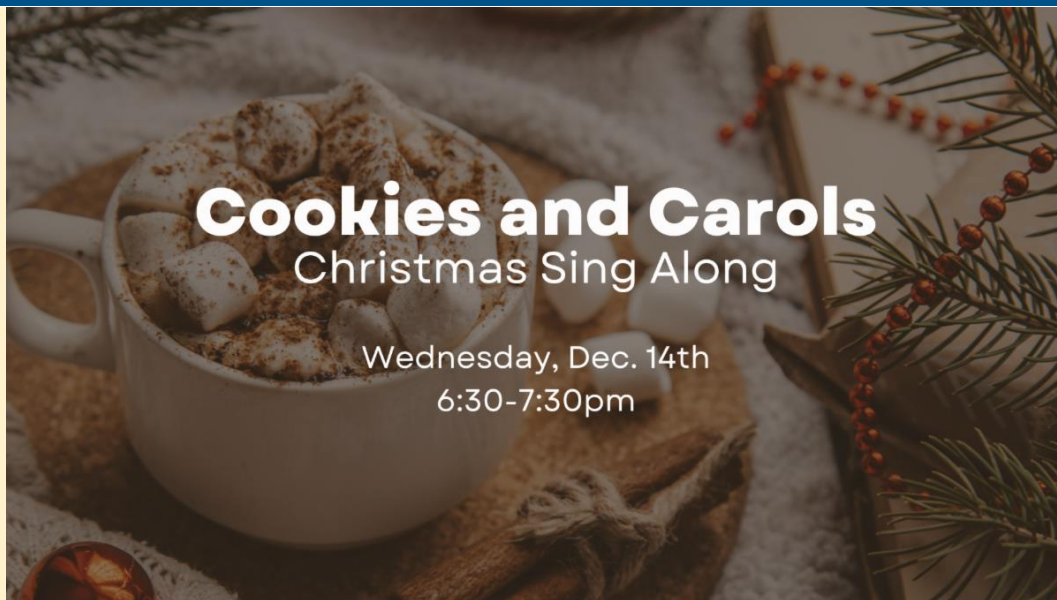



Charitable Contributions

The end of the year is upon us and we are hoping to end this year and begin a new one strong. Donors must deliver checks to the church by Thursday, December 29th in order to claim a charitable contribution deduction for 2022. Checks that are placed in the church offering during the first worship service in 2023 will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2022, even if the check is predated to 2022 or was actually written in 2022. However, checks that are *written, mailed, and postmarked in 2022* will be deductible in 2022, though these may not be received by a church until 2023.
