Thank you for being a part of the FBCNN family! We wish every one of you a Merry Christmas and may God bless you throughout the upcoming year!

Checks that are placed in the church offering during the first worship service in 2023 will not qualify for a charitable contribution deduction in 2022, even if the check is predated to 2022 or was actually written in 2022. However, checks that are *written, mailed, and postmarked in 2022 will* be deductible in 2022, though these may not be received by a church until 2023.
