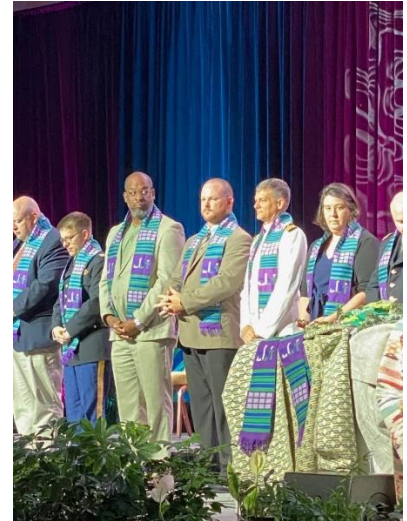




## Juan Garcia Elected as Moderator-Elect of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship
