

Guest Preacher Chuck Harrison Sunday, September 3 & 10

Chuck Harrison, Director of Missions for the Peninsula Baptist Association, will be preaching at the 8:30 and 11am services Sunday, September 3rd and September 10th.

Chuck was born and raised in Norfolk where he attended Norview High School and Old Dominion University graduating with a bachelor's degree in Philosophy. He then attended Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary where he received a Master of Divinity degree.

Chuck became a Christian at the age of 17. Early in his career he served churches in Virginia Beach, Wake County, N.C. and Richmond in the areas of youth and education ministry. He then served six years as pastor of First Colonial Baptist Church in Virginia Beach.

His next place of service was as Congregational Missionary with the Norfolk Baptist Association where he worked for six years in consulting, coaching and training church planters and pastors of turnaround churches. He also served as a part-time Regional Church Planting Strategist for the Baptist General Association of Virginia for two years.

Following that ministry he served at Crossroads Community Church in York County as Associate Pastor and later as Lead Pastor. In December of 2010 he became Director for the Peninsula Baptist Association.

Chuck is married to Peggy and they have six grown children. Chuck and Peggy love time spent with grandkids, day trips around Virginia, vacations in the Outer Banks and trips to big cities. He also loves photography, and saltwater fishing.
