## Requiem for the Living Concert Sunday, October 29 at 4pm

On Sunday, October 29 at 4 PM, the FBC Sanctuary Choir will host several other peninsula churches in the performance of Dan Forrest's Requiem for the Living. A Requiem, at its core, is a prayer for rest - traditionally, for the deceased. The five movements of Dan Forrest's Requiem for the Living, however, form a narrative just as much for the living, and their own struggle with pain and sorrow, as for the dead. This performance, under the direction of Dr. John Irving, brings together area musicians in a multi-denominational choir and a small chamber ensemble to perform for the glory of God. It will be a community choral performance you won't want to miss!
