On Sunday, October 29 at 4 PM, the FBC Sanctuary Choir will host several other peninsula churches in the performance of Dan Forrest's Requiem for the Living. A Requiem, at its core, is a prayer for rest - traditionally, for the deceased. The five movements of Dan Forrest's Requiem for the Living, however, form a narrative just as much for the living, and their own struggle with pain and sorrow, as for the dead. This performance, under the direction of Dr. John Irving, brings together area musicians in a multi-denominational choir and a small chamber ensemble to perform for the glory of God. It will be a community choral performance you won't want to miss! There will be childcare available for children ages 5 and under.

Other Ways of Giving to FBCNN

Here at FBCNN, we are very grateful for your continuous support. We are doing ministry and we are reaching out to those in need through you and your funding and collaboration.

While we are eternally grateful for every cash contribution, we would like to remind you of several other ways of giving, which may align more favorably with your financial goals and tax planning. We hope that you keep this as a guide for your future contributions.



Gifts of Stock or Appreciated Assets: If you own stocks, bonds or mutual funds that have appreciated in value, you can donate them to FBCNN. This method of giving allows you to avoid capital gains taxes that would be due if you sold the assets, and you may also be eligible for a tax deduction based on the full fair market value of the assets at the time of the gift.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs): If you must take required minimum distributions (RMD) from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA), you can donate up to \$100,000 of your RMD directly to FBCNN without it being counted as taxable income. This can lower your income and taxes, while fulfilling your RMD.

Grants from Donor Advised Funds: If you have a donor-advised fund (DAF), you can recommend a grant to FBCNN. DAFs offer flexibility in terms of when you receive your tax benefit, enabling you to donate cash, stocks or non-publicly traded assets like real estate, and receive an immediate tax deduction. You can then recommend grants over time to FBCNN or other charities of your choice.

Each of these methods can offer significant tax benefits over cash donations, depending on your individual circumstances. We recommend that you consult with your financial advisor or tax professional to determine the best way for you to give.

Building Project Updates

Dear FBCNN Family:

Fall is here and as we move forward with the maintenance of our church building, we want to keep you up to date on the projects happening here:

1. Fire System Upgrade - \$23,971 - New fire panels completed.
2. 2/3rds Parking Lot Repair - \$42,000 - Sealcoat and striping completed.
3. Concrete Repair - \$28,327 - completed
4. Steeple Window Tinting - \$5,000 (Estimated cost)
5. Building Security (Phase 3) - \$15,000 (Estimated cost)
6. Sanctuary Lights - \$48,564 (Estimated cost)
7. 1/3rd Parking Lot Upgrade - Pending.

We have been able to complete these projects with the designated monies received from you, the VDOT settlement, and savings from previous years.


