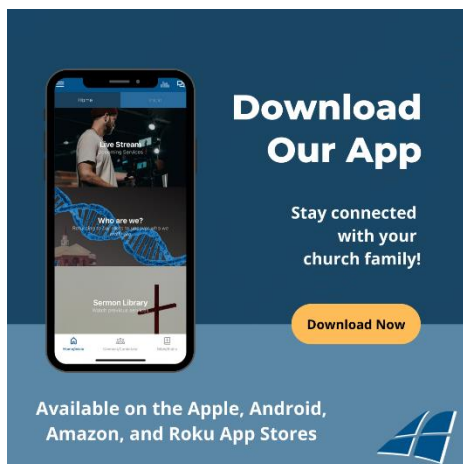
Weekly Worship Opportunities
