

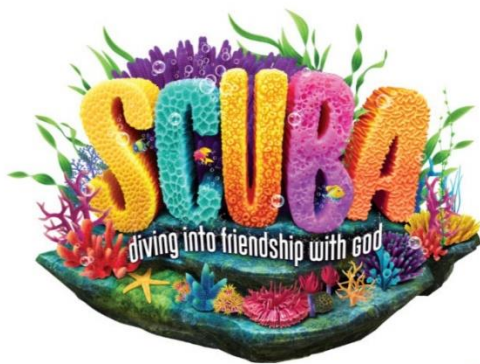


Pray for Our Group Heading to Passport Kids Camp Wednesday, June 12 - Saturday, June 15

June 13 - Peninsula Mobile Food Bank will be in our parking lot. If you or someone you know is facing food insecurity, please let them know about this opportunity.

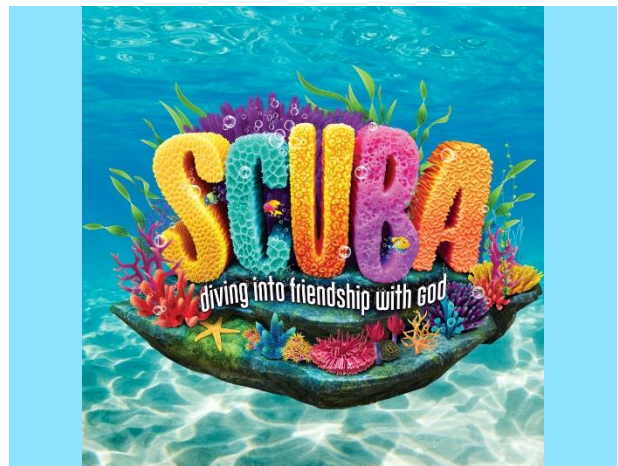


