It is hard to believe that my family and I have been part of the First Baptist Church of Newport News for 10 years. It has been an incredible journey alongside all of you. I want to thank our Personnel Committee, staff, and church as a whole for the kind words and gifts shared with us in worship on Sunday, March 30. The flowers for Alice, the tie, the quarter zip jacket, the framed picture with the powerful quote from Franklin D. Roosevelt, and the generous financial gift were all deeply appreciated. I have already enjoyed wearing my tie and quarter zip, and the picture is already hanging up in my office. I hope you will stop by and see it!

Most of all, thank you for your encouragement, cards, and prayers. We have faced significant challenges as a congregation over these ten years. Through all of them, God has been faithful and you have been resilient. Though we have seen hard seasons, God is continuing to grow and shape us. Since the beginning of 2021, our total average worship attendance has grown 49.7%. May we continue the good work of faithful worship attendance, inviting our

our building loan through your generous giving of \$1,627,698. In March 2015 we owed \$1,899,925 and our loan amount as of February 2025 is now \$272,227. However, we find our opportunities limited by this financial obligation as we consider pursuing new dreams and visions for our church.

By paying off this debt, we are investing in our future — both for the next generation and in fulfilling our current goals. Being debt-free will free up resources, allowing us to focus on expanding our mission, both within and outside our church. We are eager to see this loan fully paid off, and we believe that this Easter is the perfect time to take significant steps toward that goal.

In order to accomplish this goal, we are seeking your financial support. Your contribution, no matter the size, would make an incredible difference in reaching our goal. We believe that through generous hearts and hands, we can pay this loan off.

Furthermore, we have amazing opportunities ahead. Our prayer walk on March 29 has opened our eyes to new possibilities for loving and serving our community. Our First Wednesday meals modelled for us by the Agape I Sunday morning Bible study class are opening new doors for fellowship and connection. Our youth and children's ministry Wednesday night gatherings continue to grow. Our youth ministry has even started its own mission team as our youth look for ways to do God's mission in our community. God continues to do new things among us!

As I close this article of thanks, I want to invite you to join me in accepting the Easter challenge put forward from our Stewardship Team (see Note from Stewardship article). Our Stewardship Team is asking us to consider giving a special gift to reduce our debt this Easter season. You have been so generous in paying down our debt. Over the last ten years, we have paid \$1,627,698 on our debt. This debt built the building housing our preschool, children's ministry, youth ministry, and largest adult Sunday morning Bible study class. This building also hosts rehearsals, special meetings, and gatherings. It is a magnet for ministry. The sooner we pay off our debt, the sooner we can redeploy these resources to serve others. If you are able, I hope you will join me in making an offering above your regular giving to reduce our debt this Easter.


