Exciting Announcement!

Literacy for Life ("L4L") has approached FBCNN about renting space in our building's "Leland Hallway", (hallway between Choir Room and Library but not including Choir Room or Library), beginning on or around June 1, 2025. FBCNN leaders have been working with L4L to finalize the details of the proposal, which we are now ready to share with the congregation. Please join us for an information session on Sunday, May 4, at 5:00 PM in Payne Hall, during which we will outline the material elements of the proposal and answer any questions you may have. L4L is currently reviewing our draft lease agreement and, if they request (and FBCNN accepts) substantive changes to the proposal after May 4, we will have an additional information session on Sunday, May 11, at 9:45 AM in Payne Hall to discuss and answer questions about those changes. Lastly, a called church conference will take place on Wednesday, May 14, for the sole purpose of voting on the final proposal (i.e., there will not be discussion or Q&A at that time).

We would like to extend thanks to our staff, Stewardship Team, Stewardship Chair Danny Adkins, Chris Johnson, Rob Brown, and other church leaders in their discernment and preparation in this process.



In the graphic above, there are 27 gray coins. As of March 2025, we owed \$270,000 on our building loan, which is substantially less than the amount of \$1,899,925 that we owed in March 2015. For every \$10,000 we collect, a coin in the graphic will turn gold. In April, we have received \$17,435 towards retiring this debt and turned one of the coins to gold! Donations can be made via check (designate "Debt Free" in the memo), online giving, bill pay, and others. No donation is too small.

Paying off this debt will free up resources to expand our mission both inside and outside of our church. In addition, it is an investment in our future, helping us to fulfill our current goals and prepare for those the next generation will have.


PAA Active Aging Pop-Up Center
