FBCNN will be hosting a "4-Pronged Approach" Breast Cancer Rally on Saturday, September 13. The 4 prongs are: eat plants, exercise regularly, limit alcohol, and maintain a healthy weight. Join local experts, community advocates, and breast cancer survivors for a special gathering in honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month. It will feature a unique blend of percussionists from local bands to "Beat the Drum" for breast cancer prevention. Everyone is invited to enjoy the music and raise your voice to support this lifesaving message.

August 20th, last week we delivered an additional 5 complete kits, 240 crayons, 8 pens, 2 pencil boxes, 24 #2 pencils, and 4 glue sticks. Also, Agape I Sunday Bible Study Class provided 11 backpacks with supplies for Kindergartners and 3 additional for a family not associated with Yates. In total, we have provided 32 complete supply kits, the 14 backpacks mentioned above, plus 520 crayons, 8 pens, 64 #2 pencils, 40 glue sticks, 80 pencil eraser tops, 1 paper folder, and 19 college rule items. Thank you for sending your blessings to our neighbors across the street!

Also due to your generosity, we collected and donated another 158 pounds of food for Thrive Peninsula. This is in addition to the 470 pounds collected and donated in July. Thank you for your continuous support for such a wonderful mission to help members of our community!
